General

ECOM is looking for LGBT Health Coordinator who will manage ECOM's approach to address HIV- and health-related needs of gay men and other MSM, and trans* people in EECA.

Responsibilities

Policy and Advocacy

- Identification of ECOM's priorities in addressing HIV-related community needs in EECA;
- Development and implementation of ECOM health-related advocacy initiatives;
- Participation in relevant international advocacy initiatives, conferences, and other events.

Situation and Needs Assessment

- Assessment of situation and needs of ECOM's members related to working on HIV and health issues;
- Assessment of HIV-related needs of gay men and MSM; contribution to assessment of HIV-related needs of trans* people in EECA, together with Advocacy Coordinator;
- Documentation and sharing of best practices in HIV and health response among MSM and trans* people in EECA.

Capacity Building, Information and Awareness Raising

- Technical support to ECOM subrecipients and partners on relevant issues;
- Monitoring and analysis of news, best practices, and scientific data and findings on HIV and health for MSM and trans people, particularly in EECA;
- Development of technical resources, documents and publications to inform technical support and advocacy.

Other

- Building and maintaining ECOM's relations with partners and donors;
- Participating in ECOM's fundraising;
- Other relevant tasks as required.

Requirements:

- Extensive experience in public health / social sciences equivalent of 5 years of working on regional and international level in related positions;
- Deep understanding of health-related needs of gay men and other MSM, and trans* people in EECA.
- Strong experience in providing technical support on health-related issues, including in developing and conducting trainings;
- Experience in preparing reports, articles;
- Excellent Russian and English language speaking and writing skills.
